

TALKING POINTS FOR CONVERSATION WITH ELECTED OFFICIALS

- As a customer of the United State Postal Service, I would like to voice my strong objection to the attempt to eliminate curbside delivery of mail in new residential subdivisions.
- My family and I want to maintain the beauty, convenience, and safety of our neighborhoods, and these factors will be compromised by the implementation of cluster box units or moving mailboxes to the same side of the street.
- We think elimination of curbside delivery is discriminatory, since only new neighborhoods are subject to cluster boxes or single-side delivery, and we pay the same for postage as those who receive mail to their door.
- Finally, we think the new rule that states that 50% of the homes in a new neighborhood must be occupied before curbside delivery begins is unfair and is only an attempt to coerce developers into installing cluster boxes or changing the location of mailboxes.
- We strongly object to this unfair practice, and ask for that you let your voice be heard against it. Thank you very much.
